Annual Student Fees Information

Why pay annual student fees?

The money provided by the school system for the Arts is almost non-existent. The Pope Choral Boosters (PCB) is a parent volunteer organization whose mission is to assist Mrs. Johns in providing the best possible chorus experience for our students. To do that, there must be supplemental funds to support the Pope Chorus. Those funds come from a \$125 fee required of each student. For families with more than one student in the chorus program, each additional fee is \$65.00. During their Senior year, an additional fee of \$50 will be added for extra expenses incurred while making the year memorable for our students. The PCB is proud to say that we remain one of the lowest fee-based organizations at Pope High School.

Student fees are **due by Friday, September 4, 2026**. If fees are not paid by this deadline, your student may not be eligible for specific activities, as stated in the PCB By-Laws, including concert participation.

What is included in the annual student fees?

The money that you pay for student fees covers the following expenses that benefit each chorus student:

- Educational items and additional staff including sheet music, accompanists (at LGPE, Cabaret, the Winter Fine Arts Showcase, and rehearsals), clinicians, substitute teacher costs for professional development and field trips (such as LGPE)
- Pope Chorus website
- Educational software
- LGPE fees, including meals and day of expenses
- Meal before singing the National Anthem at Pope Football
- Cabaret choreographers and meals during tech week
- Meal during Winter Fine Arts Showcase
- One (1) student meal at EOY Banquet
- Senior student eligibility to be considered for scholarships
- Dry fit chorus shirt for the informal uniform (new students)
- Yearbook ad
- Magnet

2026-2027 Chorus Uniform Information

Informal Uniform for all students. Dry fit chorus shirt and black pants

- New students who do not have a dry fit shirt will receive one with paid annual student fees.

Formal Uniform for Women and Men:

Concert jacket and pants

- Flat or low heel black closed toe dress shoes
- Simple earrings (no larger than a quarter) and hair accessory (limited to one black ribbon)

Men

Concert jacket and pants

- Black socks and black dress shoes (no tennis shoes)

New chorus students will receive a garment bag with their paid annual student fees.

What does your sponsorship fund?
